Prenatal Provider Screening Rates: How Does Your Office Rank?

Interpreting your numbers:

Forms processed - this is the total number of forms (for your patients residing in Orange County) submitted by your office, which should reflect the total number of new OB patients your office serves

Consent to Screen - This reflects the number of patients who have signed consenting to be screened, thus completing the screening questions; therefore, the higher the consent-to-screen rate, the better job staff are doing in explaining the purpose and importance of completing the screening form

Offices with a very low number of forms processed are outlined in red as an indicator that you may not be in compliance with Florida Statute 383.14



Your office does not meet screening standards because your consent-to-screen rate is lower than 80! Are your staff aware of screening requirements and do they understand the purpose of screening and services that are available? You may benefit from a staff training. Watch out if your number of forms processed is highlighted for being too low and a possible indicator that you are not in compliance with screening statutes.

Your office is on track with a consent-to-screen rate between 80% to 89%! Watch out if your number of forms processed is highlighted for being too low and a possible indicator that you are not in compliance with screening statutes.

Your office is an exemplary screener with a consent-to-screen rate of 90% or higher! Keep up the great work, but watch out if your number of forms processed is outlined for being too low and a possible indicator that you are not in compliance with screening statutes.
